PETITION FOR GAS TAX FAIRNESS

What is this about?

On every litre of gasoline, drivers pay a tax of 14.7 cents to the provincial government.

It all adds up to \$2.3 billion collected by the McGuinty government every year.

Yet, despite crumbling roads and bridges, municipalities in Wellington-Halton Hills are denied stable and predictable infrastructure funding.

This petition calls on the McGuinty Liberals to distribute gas tax revenues **fairly** to all municipalities across Ontario—not just to cities with transit systems, as it does today.

Why should I care?

Residents of Wellington-Halton Hills are getting hosed at the pumps.

High gas prices are bad enough. But it's even worse when the Liberals at Queen's Park take our tax dollars and refuse to reinvest them in our community.
